

Rear Swaybar

2016+ Ford Focus RS

Installation Instructions For Kit #555-1019

• A qualified technician should be used if you are not confident with replacing the rear swaybar assembly.

Removal of the factory rear swaybar

- 1. Lift the rear of the car so that the rear wheels are off the ground. Use caution operating a lift or jack stands to ensure the car is stable and safe to work around and underneath.
- 2. Remove the two flange head bolts and the TORX button head bolt from the support braces. See figure 1. Repeat for the opposite side.
- Remove the 18mm flange nut from the swaybar end link by using an 18mm box end
 wrench and a 6mm hex key. See figure 2. Repeat for the opposite side. NOTE: Do NOT
 allow the ball joint stud to spin as this may cause damage to the joint.
- 4. Remove the two 13mm head flange bolts from the swaybar subframe mounts. See figure 2. Repeat for the opposite side.
- 5. Remove the swaybar assembly from the car.

Installation of the Steeda rear swavbar

- Generously grease the inside of the polyurethane swaybar bushings and the outside of the centering washers with the supplied grease packet.
- 7. Slip the bushings and brackets over the swaybar to the outside of the centering washers. See figure 3.
- Install the swaybar in the same location and orientation as the factory swaybar. Use the provided spacer in between the subframe and the swaybar bracket.
- 9. Torque the swaybar bolts to 42 ft-lbs.
- 10. Reinstall all factory components that were removed.
